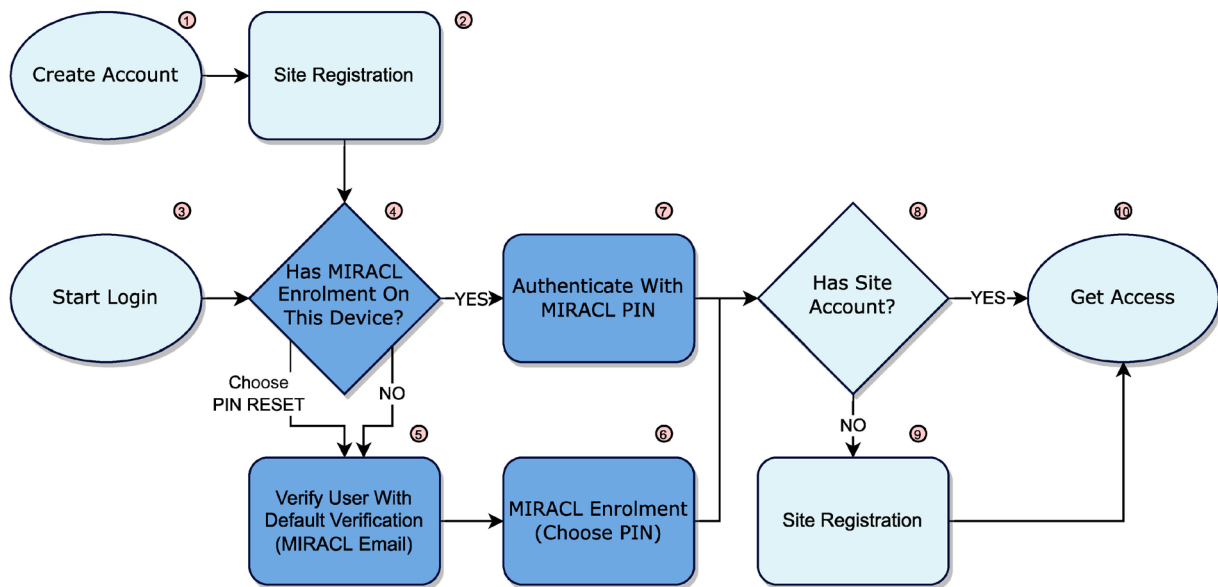


MIRACL Using Default Verification



Steps are either;

1. The User creates an account on the site, or an account is created for them
2. The process of creating an account on the site is completed

OR

3. The User selects the client site Login link or button
4. Does this particular user have an identity registered (enrolled) on this particular device, where device could mean a specific browser on that device. A user can also choose to reset their PIN
5. Using DEFAULT verification means that MIRACL will send an EMAIL to the registered user's email address with a 1-time link which will allow them to enrol the device / browser where that link is opened
6. Enrolment means using the mPINPAD to ask the user to type their PIN, and then ask them to type it again to re-confirm their choice
7. Authentication requires that the user is asked to type their PIN on the mPIN-PAD
8. Does the user have site access, i.e. access to that service that is sitting behind the MIRACL authentication service
9. Request that the user registers for site access, this is the same process as number 2
10. Process End, user has access to the site/resource
